

Jennifer Fraser, serves as managing director of Division I at the NCAA national office. As a former director of academic and membership affairs, athletic administrator on campus and in conference offices, she returned to Indianapolis in May 2015. In her current role she serves as primary liaison to the NCAA Division I Council and works directly with the Board of Directors. During her previous tenure at the NCAA she supported the Division I Committee on Academic Performance, where she played a significant role in that committee's academic reform efforts.

As a primary staff liaison to committees, Fraser helped implement the revised Division I governance structure and worked on a number of policy initiatives, including time management, transfer issues, initial eligibility standards and transformation.
