PROGRAM OVERVIEW

SFIA offers an incredible opportunity for military veterans to transition their leadership skills, discipline, and teamwork experience into rewarding civilian careers in the sports and fitness industry. VetsEXCEL represents our commitment to supporting America's military heroes as they navigate this important career change.

This four-month + cohort experience runs from the fall through the winter months. It features a targeted curriculum designed by industry leaders who understand both military experience and the needs of the sports industry. Selected applicants will become **Fellows** in the program, building their network, exploring career paths, and gaining the insights needed to launch successful civilian careers in sports and fitness.

The 2025 cohort will include up to 10 carefully selected Fellows. The VetsEXCEL Committee will oversee the selection and delivery of programs, ensuring maximum impact for each participant.

Military nonprofit partners may nominate **one (1) qualified candidate only •** A senior leader will lead the internal nomination process • Submit completed nomination and application forms to: vetsexcel@sfia.org by September 19, 2025 • Nominating organization must be pre-approved by the VetsEXCEL Leadership Committee

Application Period: August 11 - September 19, 2025

FELLOW ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must meet these criteria:

- Military Service: Honorably discharged from any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces and all components Recent Transition: Must have transitioned from the military within the last five years
- Industry Interest: Demonstrated passion for building a career in sports and fitness Education: Hold an associate degree or be working toward the completion of a bachelor's or master's degree within the next two years Leadership Potential: Evidence of leadership capabilities and professional growth mindset Commitment: Available to participate fully in program activities

Please note: This is a supplemental, part-time endeavor. This is not a full-time commitment. Instead, it is intended to complement any ongoing professional development.

SELECTION PROCESS

Timeline:

- 1. Application (Fellow candidates and Mentors) Window Opens: Week of August 11, 2025
- 2. Application Deadline: September 19, 2025 (6-week application window)
- 3. Application Review Period: Week of September 22, 2025
- 4. Fellow & Mentor Pairing Announcement: Week of September 29, 2025
- 5. Selection Notification: Week of October 6, 2025
- 6. Initial Group Call: Week of October 13, 2025
- 7. **Kickoff**: Veterans Day Week (November 10-14, 2025)



Selection Criteria: • Military service record and leadership experience • Demonstrated interest in sports and fitness industry • Potential for career growth and industry contribution • Commitment to program participation • Contribution to cohort diversity • Alignment with fellow-led programming model
