

The Honorable Donald M. Remy

Donald M. Remy's career spans the highest levels of law, sports, business, and government. Confirmed by the United States Senate in a 91-8 bipartisan vote, he served as the Deputy Secretary of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. As Chief Operating Officer and Chief Legal Officer of the NCAA, he oversaw legal affairs and operations for the billion-dollar organization of over 1,200 institutions and half a million student-athletes. He negotiated innovative media rights agreements, managed landmark legal cases, and championed reforms expanding student-athlete opportunities. As a partner at Latham & Watkins, he handled high-stakes investigations and complex compliance matters, and at O'Melveny & Myers, substantial class action litigation. His career also includes service as a business, legal, and governance executive at Fannie Mae, as a Deputy Assistant Attorney General at the Department of Justice, as an Assistant to the General Counsel of the U.S. Army, and as a law clerk to the 6th Circuit U.S. Court of Appeals. He remains active in sports as an owner and investor in the DC Power Football Club and anticipates investment in an expansion professional volleyball team.
